Here is how to help get your child started on a computer:

- Click on the button in the banner: CLASSLINK- it will bring you to this page: https://launchpad.classlink.com/moravia
- Click the Sign in with Google button (use your student's Google username/password)
- Click the Quick Card circle and enable the camera on the device

Here is how to help get your child started on a mobile device:

- Download the appropriate app: ClassLink LaunchPad iOS Google Play
- Search for and choose "Millard Fillmore Elementary School" or "Moravia Junior-Senior High School" - This will bring you to our school logo.
- Click the Sign in with Google button (use your student's Google username/password)
