Discuss the role of citizen participation in the United States Government, drawing upon historical examples and contemporary challenges. The essay may also consider whether the United States could truly be described as a democracy at various points in its history, and how citizen participation played a role in its democratic evolution.***


The student should refer to the United States Constitution and its Amendments to support their answer.

There is no right or wrong answer. Students will not be judged on their position as long as it is well supported and explained. The Bar Association Scholarship Committee is interested in determining how well the student understands the issue, as well as how their answer is supported by referencing the United States Constitution and its Amendments.

Please pay strict attention to the 1,000 word limitation. The deadline for submission is April 19, 2024 at 5:00 p.m. All submissions must be forwarded to the Law Office of Norman J. Chirco, Esq., at 95 Genesee Street, Auburn, New York 13021. Submissions may be made in paper form or by email at the address shown above.
