

The faculty and staff of Moravia Central School District are looking forward to welcoming back our students for the 2021-2022 school year.

In accordance with requirements issued by the New York State Health Department, the following expectations and protocols will be in place to keep all members of our school community safe:

- All Moravia educational programs will be in-person, five days each week.
- All students and staff will wear a mask when inside our school buildings or on school buses, regardless of vaccination status.
- Students should not attend school if showing any symptoms of COVID-19, including: new loss of taste/smell, difficulty breathing, vomiting, diarrhea, fever (100 or higher), cough, severe headache, sore throat, runny nose.
- Mask breaks will continue to be provided at the teacher's discretion, when appropriate social distancing is possible.
- Masks are not required outside.
- The Moravia campus will be sanitized throughout the day and will be disinfected every night.
